Dangerous Goods Notification System

Terms of use:

Under Section 4 of the City of Helsinki Port Regulations, advance notice of all dangerous goods transported through the Port of Helsinki must be given in good time, not later than 24 hours prior to the entry of the consignment in the port, unless otherwise agreed upon.

Goods classified as dangerous refer to goods covered by the International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG Code), the European Agreement on the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR), and the European Regulations Concerning the International Transport of Dangerous Goods by Rail (RID).

The Dangerous Goods Notification System is an online service provided by the Port of Helsinki, and it can be used free of charge. The website is a database-based online service for the monitoring and notification of classified substances. It must be used according to the directions of the Port of Helsinki.

The Dangerous Goods Notification System may only be used for notification procedures related to the transport of dangerous goods through the Port of Helsinki.

Registered users are given user IDs for the system. User IDs are personal and may not be disclosed to others.

The Port of Helsinki maintains the website and is responsible for its appearance and content. The Port of Helsinki has the right to make changes to the pages and restrict access to them. The Port of Helsinki does not guarantee faultless service or interruption-free access to it nor is it liable for any indirect or direct damages caused by the use of its pages.
